I just received your letter Ap. 23 together with the two books one defining the ASP the other describing the method of kick boxing.

The kick boxing method has a great similarity with la Boxe Française; strangely so. Most of the blows - kicks or fists - are similar. The attitudes and way of delivery a quite different. As you probably have read, la Boxe Française has been developed a little over one hundred years ago in joining the "savate" - which not more than a few kicks used by toughs - and the regular fist boxing known as English-boxing.

The facts together have been carefully developed and codified so as to make a highly scientific art which is a magnificent sport in its own right. Highly educative it is the only sport which is a complete method of physical culture --

I hope we could meet some times to demonstrate the French method, and its efficiency. Perhaps if you have had time to examine at length the book which I send you you have detected some basic differences in the attitudes (in position) which determine blows.
